SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Billings Section of the Society of Petroleum Engineers (SPE), Inc. is pleased to announce the availability of scholarships to qualified Montana Tech and Montana State students enrolled in a petroleum related engineering curriculum. These scholarships are not need based. The recipients will be chosen based upon academic merit, extracurricular activities, and written essays. We anticipate awarding two \$1500.00 scholarships in the spring of 2009 – one to a student entering his or her sophomore year and one to a student entering his or her junior or senior year. The funds will be paid to the students upon verification of enrollment in an accredited engineering program.

Applications must be received by March 13, 2009. Applications received after this date will not be considered. Scholarship applicants will be notified by mail by April 24, 2009.

It is requested that this application be forwarded to all engineering students.

Scholarship winners and their parents will be invited to attend as honored guests of the Billings Section a SPE luncheon to be held in Billings in April or May 2009.

The Billings Section of the SPE reserves the exclusive right to determine the number and amount of scholarships awarded for any given school year. The completion and submittal of a completed application does not obligate the Billings Section of the SPE to award a scholarship to any applicant.
